

RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 55

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDOMAR, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT TO THE OFFICE OF THIS CITY THAT WERE TO BE ELECTED ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024 IN DISTRICT 2

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, as of the close of the nomination period on August 9, 2024, there are not more candidates than offices to be elected and that § 10229 of the Elections Code allows one of the following courses of action to be taken by the City Council:

1. Appoint to the office the person who has been nominated.
2. Appoint to the office any eligible elector if no one has been nominated.
3. Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated.

WHEREAS, the City Clerk's certification that there were not more candidates than offices to be elected in District 2 was submitted to the City Council and is attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, a notice was published on August 14, 2024 in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to law and is attached as Exhibit B.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILDOMAR, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to § 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the following action is being taken:

The following person is being appointed to the office in **District 2** to which he was nominated, and is considered to be the same as being elected, pursuant to § 10229(a)(3) of the Elections Code:

NAME	OFFICE	TERM
Dustin Nigg	Member of the City Council	Full 4 Year Term

SECTION 2. The election scheduled to be held in District 2 on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, is now canceled.

SECTION 3. The person appointed shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for the office.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

If, by the 75th day before the municipal election, no person has been appointed to the office(s) pursuant to (1) or (2) above, the election shall be held.

If the City Council makes an appointment pursuant to § 10229, Elections Code, the City Clerk shall not accept for filing any statement of write-in candidacy which is submitted after the appointment is made.
