Subject: Eligibility for Additional California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA) State Share Funding under Government Code 65302.6 (Assembly Bill 2140)

Dear Mr. Berroteran,

The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) received a Resolution of Adoption from the City of Wildomar to adopt their current, FEMA-approved Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) into the Safety Element of their General Plan. Cal OES has determined that the city is compliant with GC 65302.6 requirements. While funding is not automatically guaranteed, the city is now eligible to be considered for additional CDAA funding if approved by legislation following a disaster.

Please keep in mind that when the city's LHMP expires on **April 18, 2028**, the adoption into the Safety Element expires and must be renewed each time the LHMP update has received either approvable pending adoption (APA) or final approval from FEMA. The onus is on the jurisdiction to provide proof of compliance to Cal OES before a new compliance letter will be issued.
